MINUTES OF MEETING OF MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE OF SARDAR KAURA KHAN TRUST HELD ON 13.11.2025 AT 1:00 P.M UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE, MUZAFFARGARH/CHAIRMAN SARDAR KAURA KHAN TRUST (REGISTERED).

In pursuance of Rule 4 Sub rule 2 of the Notification No.SOR-(LG) 38-24/2015 dated 04.03.2016, a meeting of the Management Committee of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust was convened on 13.11.2025 at 1:00 p.m. under the Chairmanship of the District & Sessions Judge/Chairman of the Trust. 3. The member mentioned at Sr. No.1 of Para 2 above conveyed through letter EnstNo. 573/SKKT. dated 10.11.2025 that he could not attend the meeting due to leave from 12.11.2025 to 15.11.2025, whereas the member mentioned at Sr. No.2 of Para 2 telephonically informed that he is busy in a training at Lahore.

4. The member mentioned at Sr. No.3 of Para 2 has not attended the meeting in person, rather, Mr. Faheem Akhtar Bhutta, Secretary District Bar Association, Muzaffargarh being Acting President of the Bar attended the meeting as the president District Bar Association, is seriously ill

5. **Mr. Rashid Mehmood**, District Forest Officer, Muzaffargarh has attended the meeting on special invitation.

6. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh has also attended the meeting.

7. The Chair welcomed the participants and members of the Management Committee. The agenda items were discussed and following decisions were made in the meeting.

AGENDA NO.1.

(REGISTRATION OF TRUST).

8. The Deputy Commissioner, Muzaffargarh apprised that Sardar Kaura Khan Trust (Registered) has been duly registered under Section 16 of the Punjab Trusts Act, 2020 from the office of Director Land Records, Board of Revenue, Punjab, Farid Kot House, Lahore vide registration No.066/86/TRUST/DLR dated 13.11.2025. He has also produced the photo copy of registration certificate in this regard.

9. The office is directed that, upon receipt of the certified copy of the duly registered trust deed, necessary intimation, along with relevant documents, be transmitted to the august Supreme Court of Pakistan as well as the Advocate General, Punjab, Islamabad, in continuation of the directions earlier issued by the Honourable Court. Similarly, it is decided to initiate further proceedings to receive tax and Zakat exemption certificates, if applicable, from the Board of Revenue/Inland Revenue as well as Zakat and Ushr Departments, respectively.

AGENDA NO.2.

(PROGRESS OF RECOVERY STATUS FROM CURRENT LEASE HOLDERS)

10. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh has disclosed that an amount of **Rs.2,37,08,154/-** has been recovered w.e.f., 29.09.2025 to 12.11.2025 of Kharif crop. In this regard, he has also submitted progress report regarding recovery of said amount.

11. The Committee emphasized the necessity of adopting a rigorous and result-oriented follow-up with all defaulting leaseholders and instructed that all available legal and administrative measures be invoked without delay to ensure the expeditious recovery of the outstanding dues. The Land

Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh is again directed to pay special attention and further improve the process of recovery of remaining lease amount and in case of any default, shall proceed in accordance to the relevant Rules.

12. The Land Superintendent, SKKT Muzaffargarh apprised the Committee that on 11.11.2025, the Auction Committee completed the auction proceedings of the remaining lots which could not be auctioned on 28.10.2025 and 29.10.2025 due to absence of bidders. Only one lot, bearing No. 1 of Mouza Jatoi Shumali, was successfully auctioned and allotted to Mr. Muhammad Shahzaib for Rs.3,13,500/- being the highest bidder. After detailed discussion, the Committee unanimously approved the auction proceedings of auction Committee dated 11.11.2025 and directed the Land Superintendent, SKKT Muzaffargarh to issue the allotment letter to the aforesaid bidder after completion of all requisite codal formalities and to refund the earnest money to the unsuccessful bidders in accordance with law & rules. The Land Superintendent SKKT, Muzaffargarh was further directed to initiate the auction proceedings of remaining lots as per rules. It is further directed that in subsequent auction proceedings, the successful bidder shall deposit the 1/4th of his winning price then & there in addition to the reserve price, he had already deposited.

(AGENDA NO.3)

(INITIATION OF STEPS TAKEN AGAINST THE EX-LAND SUPERINTENDENT, SKKT, M. GARH AND EX-RECOVERY CLERK IN PURUSANCE OF INQUIRY REPORTS SUBMITTED BY MR. GHULAM SHABBIR HUSSAIN, LEARNED ADDITIONAL DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE, JATOI)

13. It has been informed that some of the inquiries against above-said officials have been dropped and in some inquiries, they have been found guilty. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh is directed to pursue the process of the inquiries and took further steps regarding the embezzlement of the above-said employees and submit his report in this regard.

14. The Inquiry Officer be again directed to finalize and decide all the remaining inquiries pending before him as early as possible, so that further impediments in recovery may be removed.

AGENDA NO.4&5.
(NUMBER/TAGGING OF THE TREES)

(PERMISSION FOR SALE OF FALLEN TREES)

15. The Divisional Forest Officer, Muzaffargarh apprised that the list of trees has been updated further and record of trees from Sr. No.254 to 982 has been prepared and in this respect, he has produced a letter dated 12.11.2025. He further apprised that a list of 104 trees (dead dry wind fallen) has also been submitted vide letter No.196/LR dated 05.11.2025. The Committee decided that the wood of said trees be utilized for the purpose of preparing the furniture such as chairs, tables, desks etc. for the Schools and office of the Trust. So, the Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh is directed to take necessary steps in this respect, to do the needful immediately.

16. It has been pointed out that so many trees are available on the lots given on lease, which also need attention of the Committee. A direction be issued to all the leaseholders of the lots to take care of the trees grown on the respective lands and if any tree is found dead or dry, then shall inform the same at the earliest to the Land Superintendent of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust (Reg), Muzaffargarh.

17. It has also been apprised that the reeds (سرکنڈے) are also available on some portion of the land of SKKT. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh has been directed to take care of the said reeds and also make arrangements regarding auction of the same at the earliest.

18. During the meeting, the Chair apprised the Committee about the software developed for comprehensive Land Record and Accounts Management of the Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh. The Committee appreciated the Chair's efforts for digitizing and consolidating the Trust's record in an efficient and modernized manner. During the discussion, the Committee emphasized the need to initiate e-tagging of all Trust lots to further enhance transparency, accessibility, and effective monitoring of land assets. In this regard, the Divisional Forest Officer, Muzaffargarh, was assigned the responsibility to facilitate the e-tagging process and ensure close coordination with the Assistant Director Agriculture and this office for timely completion of the task

AGENDA NO.6 & 7.

(RECOVERY OF RENT OF GOVT. BUILDINGS)

- a. **Live Stock Department.**
- b. **Revenue Department.**
- c. **Rescue 1122**
- d. **District Support Office,**
- e. **Municipal Committee.**

19. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh apprised that despite repeated directions and issuance of notices to the representative of all the concerned Departments qua immediate pursuing the matter regarding recovery of rent and ensure earliest depositing the outstanding rent amount, the same has not yet been deposited.

20. During the discussion, the Deputy Commissioner, Muzaffargarh requested that the rent of the Government Buildings presently occupied by above said Government Departments be exempted. The Chair, however, clarified the legal position and drew the Committee's attention to the clear direction contained in the order of the august Supreme Court of Pakistan dated 11.10.2018, wherein it was categorically held that:

“Buildings constructed on land in the name of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust to house various offices of the Provincial Government, including the judiciary, will be leased out on such terms and conditions as the Management Committee may determine. Income derived from such leases along with arrears thereof will be deposited in the Trust accounts.”

21. The matter may further be discussed in next meeting. It is pertinent to mention here that three departments, i.e., Judiciary, Police and Live Stock are paying the rent regularly. Any further decision would be made keeping in view the order of the august Supreme Court of Pakistan as mentioned supra.

AGENDA NO.8.

(PROPOSED ANNOTATED REPLY OF AUDIT PARAS)

22. The Deputy Commissioner, Muzaffargarh ensured the Chair that the annotated reply of the audit paras are almost complete, which shall be submitted at the earliest for perusal.

AGENDA NO.9.

**(APPLICATION REGARDING ILLEGAL OCCUPANT AT LOT NO.1
& 2, MAUZA NOORPUR, TEHSIL RAJANPUR)**

23. The Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur apprised that as per report No.279/Reader, dated 12.11.2025, Malik Imdad Hussain s/o Muhammad Bakhsh and Hazoor Bakhsh s/o Wahid Bakhsh were appointed as Superdars of land measuring 74 Kanal, 13 Marlas, MouzaNoorpur and land measuring 159 Kanal, 04 Marlas, MouzaRaqbaNaseer, respectively to hold and safeguard the said properties until the auction of the aforementioned lots is duly conducted..

24. The Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur assured the Committee that the amount recovered from the illegal occupants shall be deposited into the account of the Sardar Kaura Khan Trust at the earliest, in compliance with legal and administrative requirements. He was directed that a progress report, along with evidence of recovery and deposit, be submitted in the next meeting.

AGENDA NO.10.

**(CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL MATTERS

25. The Deputy Commissioner, Muzaffargarh and Rajanpur submitted their respective reports regarding appointment of field staff and other officials including pay scale/salary structure. Similarly, vide letter No.217/NTO-Br, dated 06.11.2025, the Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur for smooth running the office of SKKT also submitted a detailed report and recommendations regarding appointments of field staff, fuel expenses (Rent car) and appointments of Patwari at District Rajanpur. After due deliberation and consultation, in order to avoid any burden upon the Trust, the

Committee unanimously approved to appoint the following ancillary staff:-

The learned Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur also suggested one post of Director in BPS-17/18 with revenue background along with three posts of Assistant Directors, i.e., Assistant Director (Finance), Assistant Director (Admin) and Assistant Director (Operations/Logistics). However, keeping in view the fact that utmost care and financial discipline is required in such like matters where Wakf money was involved; and because not even a single penny should be wasted and only the above-mentioned posts could be advertised & recruited; and later on, if found necessary and feeling the necessity of above-said posts, the recruitment of further posts as suggested above would be made. With that, otherwise it is a good proposal and it would be an ideal situation and that very proposal might enhance the working capacity of trust. Necessary procedure be initiated immediately for effecting working of the Trust. Similarly, it is suggested by the learned Deputy Commissioner, Muzaffargarh that a caretaker-cum-gardener-cum-sweeper be recruited to keep clean the tomb of philanthropist/donor situated at Jatoi. The same was not opposed and it is also allowed accordingly.

26. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh is directed to make necessary arrangements regarding appointment of said field staff at the earliest.

27. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh made a request vide No.115/SKKT dated 22.09.2025 qua enhancement of fuel charges as well as rent of the car regarding his tour qua recovery of lease amount and other purposes. The Committee unanimously approved 250-liter petrol per month and Rs.3000/- per

day for rent of the car, to meet the effective working environment w.e.f. 01.12.2025 to the Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh.

ADDITIONAL MATTERS.

(SCHOOL MATTERS)

28. In the last meeting, the Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh was directed to obtain a rough cost estimate for the renovation and provision of furniture for the SKKT Public Schools. The Land Superintendent informed the Committee that he had approached the Executive Engineer, Buildings Department, Muzaffargarh for preparation of the required rough cost estimate vide letter No. 254/SKKT dated 10.11.2025; however, the estimate is still awaited.

29. The Committee expressed concern over the delay and directed the Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh to actively pursue the matter with the Buildings Department and ensure that the rough cost estimate for the renovation of the Schools is submitted to this office within two weeks, so that further necessary action may be taken in the matter.

30. The Principal, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust School, Kot Addu, submitted a request drawing attention to the urgent need for strengthening the security arrangements of the school. The Principal apprised the Committee of the current security challenges and the necessity of implementing enhanced measures to ensure the safety of students, staff, and school property. In view of the prevailing security situation across the country and considering the sensitivity of educational institutions, the Committee thoroughly deliberated on the matter and unanimously approved the request of the Principal. The Land Superintendent SKKT, Muzaffargarh is directed to get estimate and submit the same in the next meeting.

(APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF FUND FOR RECREATIONAL TOUR OF STUDENT OF SKKT SCHOOLS)

31. An application seeking financial assistance for arranging a recreational tour for the students of SKKT Public School, Jatoi, was presented before the Committee. After due consideration, the Committee unanimously approved the proposed recreational

tour, acknowledging the educational, recreational, and motivational benefits of such activities offer to students.

32. *During the meeting while discussing the matter, learned Deputy Commissioner, Muzaffargarh has put forward a very good and appreciated suggestion of a scheme for all the schools working under the Trust, on the rationale that the basic and primary object is to provide quality education to the students, and the study cum recreational trips are considered a way to provide a balanced learning experience that combines academic enrichment with personal development. Learned Deputy Commissioner has rightly further pointed out that the purpose of schools education under the trust at all tehsils should be of high quality standard, multifaceted focusing on developing students intellectually, socially, and personally to become informed, responsible and capable members of society and where the students be brought up in a fine manner with satisfactory grooming. Certainly, it might be the basic purpose of the trust. The said thinking of the learned Deputy Commissioner was not opposed, rather, endorsed by all participants of the meeting. Therefore, it is unanimously decided that necessary steps be taken for education and grooming of the students and uplifting of schools in terms of education and infrastructure.*

At this stage, it was further suggested that different teams were sent for the effective working of three schools working under the Trust at Tehsil level and report was submitted by the Principal, Sardar Kaura Khan School, Jatoi as well as Chief Executive (Education), the NGO governing Recep Tayyip Erdogan Hospital, Muzaffargarh for further improvements and necessary repairs and provide the staff as well as equipment. Similarly, it is a need to improve environment of all the three schools of Trust working at Tehsil level, with respect to repair and by improving the ground and other sports facilities for proper up-bringing of the students and in this regard, necessary expenditure be incurred accordingly, subject to provision of the funds etc. Similarly, it is further decided that necessary teachers be also recruited for the better working of the schools and report be called and after that,

the process of the recruitment of the teachers be completed. In the same way, further process be initiated and completed for permanent registration of all three schools working at Tehsil level. Likewise, in case, some necessary steps are required for the repair of the building, four-wall, security arrangements, technical facilities as well as building facilities, grounds etc, the necessary steps be taken in this regard, subject to intimation and keeping its proper record for audit.

33. In this context, the Committee approved an amount of Rs. 80,000/- for the recreational tour of SKKT Public School, Jatoi. The Principals of all remaining SKKT schools are directed to submit their respective proposals for similar kind recreational or educational tours.

(PERMISSION TO HIRE A DAILY WAGES TEACHER FOR PRE-SCHOOLS)

34. A request submitted by the Principal, Sardar Kaura Khan School, Jatoi, seeking permission to hire a teacher on a daily-wage basis for the Pre-School section, was placed before the Committee for consideration. The Principal reported that due to the increasing number of pre-school students and the consequent rise in workload, an additional teacher is urgently required to ensure smooth academic functioning and to maintain the desired standard of early childhood education.

35. After deliberation, the Committee unanimously approved the request, acknowledging the essential need for adequate teaching staff for pre-schoolers.

(APPLICATION FOR CHANGE OF CADRE, i.e., SCIENCE GRADUATE SUBMITTED BY MISS AFIFA)

36. An application was submitted by Miss Afifa, General Teacher at Sardar Kaura Khan School, Jatoi, requesting a change of cadre from General Teacher to Science/Biology Teacher. After due discussion, the committee decided that she may participate, in case the requisite faculty is advertised and recruited and her request would be considered at that time accordingly.

(APPLICATION FOR CANCELLATION OF LOT NO. 112/1 MAUZA RAMPUR-I)

37. Mr. Muhammad Kashif, leaseholder of lot No.112/1 Mauza Rampur-I, has moved an application for cancellation of lease agreement of said lot. According to report submitted by Assistant Commissioner, Jatoi bearing No.1036/AC dated 27.10.2025, said lot is comprising of land measuring 200-Kanals, out of which 140-Kanals land is cultivatable and out of said 140-Kanals land, crop of road grass has been cultivated on land measuring 120-Kanals and crop of maize has been cultivated on land measuring 20-Kanals, whereas the remaining 60-Kanals land is barren (Banjir Qadeem) in shape of soil mount. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh is directed to get the said land analyzed from the expert of the Agriculture Department and submit report in this regard within fifteen (15) days. The applicant present before the Committee is directed to deposit/clear the previous outstanding lease amount.

(APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY MR. GHULAM RASOOL REGARDING LOT NO. 7, JATOI)

38. One Ghulam Rasool, leaseholder of lot No.07 Jatoi, has moved an application with the version that total lot leased out to him is comprising of 112 Kanal, but he is in possession of only 80 Kanals of land. According to report submitted by Assistant Commissioner Jatoi bearing No.1016/AC dated 23.10.2025, the District Council was owner of land measuring 112-Kanals in Khata No.423, Mauza Jatoi Janobi, out of this land, a piece of land measuring 26-Kanals, 16-Marlas has been transferred to T.M.A Jatoi vide mutation No.6133 dated 23.11.2005 by the order of District Officer Revenue Muzaffargarh dated 15.09.2005 and the remaining land, now owned by Sardar Kaura Khan Trust in Khata No.423 is 85 Kanal, 04 Marlas. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh is directed to get transfer the said land in favour of Trust, while cancelling the above-said mutation and then get the possession of said land.

(APPLICATION MOVED BY KHALIL AHMAD LEASEHOLDER OF LOT NO. 113/1 RAMPUR-I, JATOI AGAINST EX-LAND SUPERINTENDENT, SKKT AND RECOVERY CLERK)

39. One Khalil Ahmad, leaseholder of lot No.113/1 Mauza Rampur-I, has moved an application drawing attention of the Committee regarding some embezzlement of the amount made by Ex-Land Superintendent, SKKT and recovery clerk. The said leaseholder has been directed to deposit the lease amount as security and after detailed deliberation, the Management Committee unanimously decided to depute **Mr. Ghulam Shabbir Hussain, learned Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Jatoi** to conduct inquiry against Muhammad Rafique, Ex-Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh and Raza Imran, Recovery Clerk purely on merit.

(APPLICATION REGARDING ISSUANCE OF SALARY MOVED BY EX-DAILY WAGES WORKER ALI RAZA)

40. After due discussion, the said application is accepted unanimously by the Committee, with the direction to the Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh to do the needful for the release of salary of said daily wages worker after completing all codal formalities.

(REQUEST FOR PAYMENT OF FEE RS.3,85,000/- MOVED BY MR. ANWAR KHAN SHERWANI, ADVOCATE/LEGAL ADVISOR SKKT)

41. After thorough discussion, the Committee unanimously the said request being genuine is approved by the Committee, with the direction to the Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh to make necessary arrangements for the payment of fee to the said Advocate after completing all coddle formalities.

(APPLICATION FOR PURCHASE OF LAPTOP AND COMPUTER SYSTEM WITH PRINTER AS WELL AS FURNITURE)

42. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh moved an application for the purchase of laptop for the purpose to manage the record of the land and schools of SKKT. After due discussion, the said request has been approved unanimously by the Committee. Another request was moved by the staff of Trust Office established at Sessions Courts, Muzaffargarh for a Computer System with Printer as well as furniture for the Office. The same was unanimously approved by the Committee.


43. The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks extended to all the participants, expressing appreciation for their attendance, contributions.


