3. The members mentioned at Sr. No.1, 3of Para 2 could not attend the meeting in persons, rather Mr. Muhammad Yousaf Cheena, Additional Deputy Commissioner (General), Muzaffargarh and Mr. Muhammad Ashraf, S.P Investigation, Rajanpur attended the meeting on their behalf respectively.

4. During the meeting, it was apprised the Committee that Deputy Commissioners, Muzaffargarh and Rajanpur are busy in online meeting with C.M Punjab.

5. **Mr. Shafqat Ali,** Sub Divisional Forest Officer, Muzaffargarh has attended the meeting on behalf of **Mr. Rashid Mehmood,** District Forest Officer, Muzaffargarh and submitted

letter No 98/L Dated 09.12.2025, which transpires that said Officer has proceeded to Lahore to attend the inquiry proceedings in the office of Deputy Director (Admin) Anti corruption Establishment Lahore Headquarter on 10.12.2025. at 11 a.m.

6. Mr. Muzaffar Hussain Khan Magsi, petitioner of writ petition No.45/1993 has attended the meeting on special invitation.

7. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh has also attended the meeting.

8. The Chair welcomed the participants and members of the Management Committee. The agenda items were discussed and following decisions were made in the meeting.

**AGENDA NO.01.**  
**(PROGRESS OF RECOVERY STATUS FROM CURRENT LEASE**  
**HOLDERS)**

9. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh apprised the Committee that an amount of **Rs. 6,402,051/-** has been recovered from the leaseholders and defaulters w.e.f. 13.11.2025 to 08.12.2025 of Kharif crop.

10. The Committee stressed that strict and effective follow-up should be made with all defaulter leaseholders. The Land Superintendent SKKT, Muzaffargarh was directed that all necessary legal and administrative steps be taken immediately to recover the outstanding dues. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh was further directed to give special attention to improve the recovery process of the outstanding lease amount and in case of any default, to take action strictly in accordance with the relevant rules and submit report in the next meeting.

11. The Land Superintendent SKKT Muzaffargarh further apprised the Committee that **292 Lots** are available for auction for Rabi-2025-2026 season and the advertisement for the auction of above said lots have been published in two National Newspaper (**Daily Express & Daily Jang**) and one Local Newspaper (**Daily Jaloos Muzaffargarh**). As per publication three dates i.e. **19, 20 & 22 December 2025** have been fixed for auction of above said lots. Furthermore, in pursuance of Rule 12(1) of the Sardar Kaura Khan (Management, Supervision and Protection of Land) Rules 2016 the

Management Committee constituted the Auction Committee comprising of following member:-

**(AGENDA NO.2)**

**(INTEREST RATE ON BANK DEPOSITS)**

12. All the Managers of Bank Branches situated in Muzaffargarh were directed vide letter No.289/SKKT dated 22.11.2025 to submit interest/markup rates individually of following category of accounts:-

- 1- Saving Account.
- 2- Fixed Deposit Account.
- 3- Special Deposit Scheme.

The below mentioned Banks submitted their markup rates as under:-

13. The comparison of the rates of all banks showed that Bank Alfalah has given high markup rate @ **11.15%PA** than all banks. The Committee unanimously approved the interest rate of Bank Alfalah

being highest and decided to withdraw 20% of deposited amount of SKKT from National Bank of Pakistan main Branch, Muzaffargarh and deposited the same in Bank Alfalah Muzaffargarh Branch.

**(AGENDA NO.3)**

**(RESERVE PRICE OF THE PROPERTIES SITUATED IN MOUZA KACHI BAKHSH, DEENPUR QASIM WALA AND KOTLA MUGHLAN).**

14. In the previous meeting the Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur were directed to submit a comprehensive report regarding Land situated in Kachi Baksh, Deenpur, Qasim wala and Kotla Mughlan, Tehsil Jampur, District Rajanpur. The Assistant Commissioner, Jampur, in this regard submitted a report vide letter No.1433/PA dated 22.11.2025, wherein he stated that 916K-17M land in Mauza Deenpur and 96 Kanal in Mauza Kachi Baksh has been resurfaced due to fall in water level of river Indus. He further submitted that remaining portion of land cultivable for a single Rabi crop and also suggested that the terms and conditions of lease as approved by Management Committee of SKKT may be relaxed to the extent of above mentioned Mauzas to attempt the auction of lots as it has been never leased for last many years. The proposals submitted by him are reproduced hereunder:-

- i. The lease rate may be fixed at a reasonable level, the single crop potential nominal lease rate of Rs.10,000/- for Rabi crop only.
- ii. The revenue field staff identified subsequent auction of small lots comprising parcel of land resurface in compact manners containing alluvial patches of land and suitable for cultivation.
- iii. Auction to hold in near vicinity of land preferably in Tehsil Jampur to facilitate and encourage farmers.
- iv. The Revenue Officers of Tehsil Jampur may be incorporated in auction committee in order to motivate local farmers to take part in auction.
- v. Waiver in case of inundation of land in winter season”.

15. The Assistant Commissioner, Jampur also proposed that developing a flexible lease mechanism to the extent of said lots the local cultivators will be encouraged to bring this land under cultivation as well as to preserve the land from erosion during summer through temporary bunds and embankments.

16. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh apprised the Committee that a fresh advertisement for auction of the lots situated in the above-mentioned Mauzas has been issued and that the reserve price has been fixed at Rs.10,000/-, as determined by the Revenue Department. In pursuance of Rule 10 of the Sardar Kaura Khan Trust (Management, Supervision and Protection of Land) Rules, 2016, notified vide Notification No. SOR-(LG) 38-24/2015 dated 04.03.2016, the Committee unanimously approved the said reserve price.

**(AGENDA NO.4)**

**(INITIATION OF STEPS TAKEN AGAINST THE EX-LAND SUPERINTENDENT, SKKT, M. GARH AND EX-RECOVERY CLERK IN PURUSANCE OF INQUIRY REPORTS SUBMITTED BY MR. GHULAM SHABBIR HUSSAIN, LEARNED ADDITIONAL DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE, JATOI).**

17. In wake of outcome of inquiries and final decision of the authority the following measures have been unanimously approved.

- i. Mr. Ishfaq Hussain Tareen Land Superintendent Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Muzaffargarh is hereby directed to move an application to the concerned Police Station for registration of criminal case against Muhammad Raffique Gujjar Ex-Land Superintendent and Muhammad Raza Imran, Ex-Recovery Clerk/ Officer for embezzlement of lease amount and issuance of bogus receipts.
- ii. The Deputy Commissioner, Muzaffargarh is also required to ensure recovery of embezzled amount from accused/officials namely Muhammad Raza Imran, Recovery Clerk/Officer.
- iii. Record manifests that accused/official Mr. Muhammad Raza Imran, Recovery Clerk/Officer was working in Health Department Muzaffargarh. Therefore, Chief Executive Officer (Health) Muzaffargarh is directed to initiate departmental proceedings against him for his misconduct and embezzlement of lease amount.

The progress report in this regard by all the above concerned shall be evaluated in the upcoming meeting of SKKT.

**AGENDA NO.5, 6& 7**  
**(PERMISSION FOR SALE OF FALLEN TREES)**

**(AUCTION OF REED, رید)**  
**(E-TAGGING PROCESS OF LAND)**

18. In the last meeting it was decided by the Committee to use all the fallen trees for manufacturing the furniture for Schools and

Offices etc. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh informed the Committee that the process of manufacturing of furniture including cutting of trees and their transportation would be a lengthy and costly. After detail discussion, the Divisional Forest Officer, Muzaffargarh was directed to provide reserved price of the fallen trees of the land of SKKT®, Muzaffargarh for their auction to this office within a fortnight.

**19.** In the last meeting, it was brought into the notice of the Committee that the reeds (سرکندے) are also available on some portion of the land of SKKT. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh was directed to take care of the said reeds and also make arrangements regarding auction of the same at the earliest. But the report dated 08.12.2025 of Divisional Forest Officer; Muzaffargarh transpires that due to cultivation operations there is no actionable reeds/ Sarkanda left at the site of Mouza Dera Kaura.

**20.** During the last meeting, the Committee emphasized the need to initiate e-tagging of all Trust lots to further enhance transparency, accessibility and effective monitoring of land assets. In this regard, the Divisional Forest Officer, Muzaffargarh, was assigned the responsibility to facilitate the e-tagging process and ensure close coordination with the Assistant Director Agriculture and this office for timely completion of the task. This agenda was also taken up by the Committee and it was decided that more efforts will be made to accomplish said task by consuming minimum exchequer of the Trust.

**AGENDA NO.8.**  
**(RECOVERY OF RENT OF GOVT. BUILDINGS)**

- a. Live Stock Department.**
- b. Revenue Department.**
- c. Rescue 1122**

**21.** The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh apprised that despite repeated directions and issuance of notices to the representative of all the concerned Departments qua immediate pursuing the matter regarding recovery of rent and ensure earliest depositing the outstanding rent amount, the same has not yet been deposited. Otherwise, the occupy land shall be evacuated from all the above said Government Departments accordingly.

22. During discussions, it was pointed out by Mr. Muzaffar Hussain Khan Magsi Petitioner of writ petition No.45/1993 that an amount of 10,000,000/- (100 Million) rupees is available with the Local Government of Punjab Account-IV. In this regard Chief Officer, District Council, Muzaffargarh has been given the task to approach the quarter concerned for recovery of said amount. He further apprised the Committee that Canal water did not reach to the ending point (نک), due to which some land of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust could not be cultivated with the Canal water. The leaseholders have to arrange other sources for cultivation which enhance their expenses. The Committee decided that in the next meeting the XEN Irrigation/Canal will be called to redress this vital issue.

**AGENDA NO.9.**

**(PROPOSED ANNOTATED REPLY OF AUDIT PARAS)**

23. The representative of Deputy Commissioner, Muzaffargarh informed the Committee that the task for submission of annotated reply of the audit paras has been assigned to Mrs. Anam Hafeez ADC (F&P), Muzaffargarh and the same are almost complete, which shall be submitted at the earliest for perusal.

**AGENDA NO.10.**

**(APPLICATION REGARDING ILLEGAL OCCUPANT AT LOT NO.1 &2, MAUZA NOORPUR, TEHSIL RAJANPUR)**

24. In the last meeting the Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur assured the Committee that the amount recovered from the illegal occupants same shall be deposited into the account of the Sardar Kaura Khan Trust at the earliest, in compliance with legal and administrative requirements. He was directed that a progress report, along with evidence of recovery and deposit, be submitted in the next meeting. But the Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur neither attended the meeting personally nor submitted progress report through any of his representative. The Committee decided to convey displeasure to said Deputy Commissioner and for submission of requisite report in the next meeting. The SP Investigation Rajanpur will also assist the Deputy Commissioner in this regard and both the Officer shall ensure the recovery from illegal occupants.

**AGENDA NO.11.**

**(APPOINTMENT OF FIELD STAFF)**

25. In the previous meeting of SKKT, it was suggested that in order to avoid any burden upon the Trust, the Committee unanimously approved to appoint the following ancillary staff:-

In this regard the advertisement for the appointment of above said field staff has been published in two National Newspaper (**Daily Express Tribune Lahore & Daily Dunia Multan**) through Director General Public Relations Punjab, Lahore. As per publication last date for submission of online applications as well as receipt hard in this office has been fixed **12, December 2025**.

27. Furthermore, the Management Committee constitutes the Recruitment Committee comprising of following members:-

28. The Convener shall be responsible for convening meetings of the Recruitment Committee, supervising scrutiny of applications, coordinating interview/test schedules, maintaining transparency of the process and submitting consolidated recommendations of the Committee to the Management Committee for approval.

**ADDITIONAL MATTERS.**

**(SCHOOL MATTERS)  
(RENOVATION OF SCHOOLS)  
(URGENT NEED FOR STRENGTHENING THE SECURITY  
MEASURES)**

29. The Land Superintendent informed the committee that he has obtained the following rough cost estimate from Executive Engineer Building Muzaffargarh of below detailed work.

**30.** *Keeping in view the prevailing law and order situations across the country, the Committee has finally decided that the following work will be done for Sardar Koura Khan Public Schools Jatoi, Alipur and Kot Adu on urgent basis.*

- i. The installation of barbed wire on the boundary walls of all the Schools of SKKT.*
- ii. The installation of security cameras in all the Schools of SKKT.*
- iii. The renovation of washrooms in all the Schools of SKKT.*
- iv. Repair/maintenance of boundary wall and gate of SKKT School Kot Adu.*

*Similarly, it has been approved that necessary funds be released immediately. At this stage, it has been pointed out that Principal of Sardar Kaura Khan School, Jatoi has submitted an application/letter while mentioning that some untoward incident has occurred as some persons while armed trespassed the school boundary and created atmosphere of terror. In the wake of that incident as reported by the Principal of Sardar Kaura Khan School, Jatoi necessary arrangements be made immediately and necessary funds be released and it would be deemed prior approval along with other necessary and immediate fulfillments of necessities as mentioned above.*

**(INTERNET FACILITY)**

**31.** *The Principals of Sardar Koura Khan Schools, Jatoi, Alipur and Kot Adu have submitted requests and the estimated cost for installing internet connections. Therefore, the Committee has approved the installation of internet connections in all schools and directed the Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh to do the needful at the earliest.*

**(SCIENCE AND COMPUTER LABS)**

**32.** *Requests have also been received from Sardar Koura Khan High School Jatoi for a science laboratory for 9th and 10th classes, and from all Sardar Koura Khan Schools for computer labs for students. The committee has approved the establishment of a science laboratory at Sardar Kaura Khan High School Jatoi and computer labs at Sardar*

Koura Khan School Jatoi, Alipur and Kot Addu. The Land Superintendent was directed to take necessary steps to establish the science laboratory and computer labs without loss of time.

**(EX-PAKISTAN LEAVE)**

33. Mrs. Farhia Kanwal, Principal of Sardar Kaura Khan School Kot Adu, has submitted a request for ex-Pakistan leave for two months to complete her PhD in Ecological Chemistry. The Committee has decided that the trust's funds are allocated for the poor and needy peoples, and the schools run by the trust are also for the poor and needy children who could not afford their School fees and expenses. **The Rules of Business Sardar Kaura Khan Public Higher Secondary School Alipur, Jatoi and Kot Adu relevant portion of which about Leave transpires that no study/extra ordinary leave with or without pay will be admissible, nor would any employee be entitle to deputation when with any other employing agency.** In the light of said rules the management committee has declined her request.

34. The Principal, Sardar Kaura Khan School, Kot Addu has moved another application with the contention that School is in need of Office Boy, Security Guards, Early Years/Subject Teachers as well as furniture, carpets and Curtains etc. The Committee decided to postpone this request till the next meeting.

**(INCREASE OF SALARY SCHOOL'S STAFF)**

35. After discussion, the **Accountant, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh**, was directed to submit a **comprehensive report** of each staff member of schools, including their **qualifications, length of service, current pay, and the date of last salary increase**, within **two (02) weeks** to this office for further consideration. At this stage, it has been further approved that salary at the rate of 05% be increased immediately of all the faculty teachers except Principal and vice Principal. It has also been further decided that in future salary will be increased as per performance of the teachers. Similarly, the fate, terms and conditions of the teacher's service would be decided on the basis of performance as would be assessed on each month. In case of failure to improve the performance, the teachers would remain no more in service and would be ousted and the competent teachers would be recruited for the vacated vacancies.

**(CHANGE OF SYLLABUS FOR PRIMARY AND ELEMENTARY CLASSES FOR THE YEAR 26-27)**

36. A request for change of syllabus for Primary and Elementary Classes for the academic year 2026-27 was received from the Principal, Sardar Kaura Khan Secondary School, Jatoi. In this regard, a report was requisitioned from the Principal, Sardar Kaura Khan Public Higher Secondary School, Muzaffargarh. The report submitted regarding the proposed change of syllabus at the Primary and Elementary levels was reviewed by the Management Committee, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh.

37. After due consideration, the Committee declined the request submitted by the Principal, Sardar Kaura Khan Secondary School, Jatoi. The Committee further decided that henceforth, the same syllabus which is being taught at Sardar Kaura Khan Public Higher Secondary School, Muzaffargarh shall be implemented in all Sardar Kaura Khan Schools. Accordingly, from the next academic year, the Oxford syllabus already being taught at Sardar Kaura Khan Public Higher Secondary School, Muzaffargarh shall be adopted and taught in Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools at Jatoi, Alipur, and Kot Adu.

**(PAYMENTS OF BILLS)**

38. The Accountant of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Muzaffargarh has reported that fees of the following newspaper advertisement published for auction of the trust's lot in the month of November, 2025, photo state bill for the month of November-2025 and 03 months pay of Ex-Daily Wages Workers are outstanding.

One Ghulam Rasool, leaseholder of lot No.07 Jatoi has moved an application with the version that total lot leased out to him is comprising of 112-Kanals, but he is in possession of only 80-Kanals of land. According to report submitted by Assistant Commissioner Jatoi bearing No.1016/AC dated 23.10.2025, the District Council was owner of land measuring 112-Kanals in Khata No.423, Mauza Jatoi Janobi, out of this land, a piece of land measuring 26-Kanals, 16-Marlas has been transferred to T.M.A Jatoi vide mutation No.6\*33 dated 23.11.2005 by the order of District Officer Revenue Muzaffargarh dated 15.09.2005 and the remaining land, now owned by Sardar Kaura Khan Trust in Khata No.423 is 85 Kanal, 04 Marlas. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh was directed to get transfer the said land in favour of Trust, while cancelling the above-said mutation and then get the possession of said land. The Land Superintendent informed the Committee he has approached the office of Additional Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), Muzaffargarh vide letter No.277/SL dated 06.12.2025 the reply/outcome of which is still awaited. The committee decided that Land Superintendent shall continuously pursue the instant matter and shall submit compliance report in the next meeting.

**(APPLICATION MOVED BY MUHAMMAD KASHIF LEASEHOLDER REGARDING CANCELLATION OF LOT NO.112/1 RAMPUR-I, JATOI)**


