5. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh has also attended the meeting.

6. The Chair welcomed the participants and members of the Management Committee. The agenda items were discussed and following decisions were made in the meeting.

(PROGRESS OF RECOVERY STATUS FROM CURRENT LEASE
HOLDERS)

7. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh apprised the Committee that an amount of **Rs.101,834,439/-** has been recovered from the leaseholders and defaulters w.e.f. 09.12.2025 to 20.01.2026 of Kharif crop.

8. The Committee laid emphasis that strict and effective follow-up should be made with all leaseholders & defaulters for recovery of outstanding amounts. The Land Superintendent SKKT, Muzaffargarh was directed that all necessary legal and administrative measures be adopted henceforth in this regard. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh was further directed to give special attention to improve the recovery process of the outstanding lease amount as recently field staff has also been provided to him for recovery. In case of any default, to take action strictly in accordance with the relevant rules and submit report in the next meeting.

(INTEREST RATE ON BANK DEPOSITS)

9. Keeping in view the interest rate, the Committee had decided in the last meeting to withdraw **20%** of deposited amount of SKKT from National Bank of Pakistan Main Branch, Muzaffargarh and deposit the same in Bank Alfalah Muzaffargarh Branch. In compliance of the decision of Committee an amount of **Rs.18,27,00,000/-** has been deposited in Bank Alfalah, Muzaffargarh Branch through cheque No.**1312651572** dated 20.01.2026.

10. The progress report with regard to recovery of embezzled amount, initiation of departmental proceedings and registration of criminal case at concerned Police Station against Muhammad Raffique Gujjar, Ex-Land Superintendent and Muhammad Raza Imran, Ex-Recovery Officer, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh. The Committee held discussion

and decided that criminal cases be registered at Anti-Corruption Establishment, Muzaffargarh. Moreover, letter No.1560/CEO (DHA) dated 20.01.2026 issued by the Chief Executive Officer (DHA), Muzaffargarh depicts that Departmental proceedings has been commenced against Mr. Muhammad Raza Imran Ex-Recovery Officer, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh. The Land Superintendent SKKT, Muzaffargarh is directed to seek progress report from their parents Department for action taken against the said delinquent officials and place the same before the committee in the next meeting. The Land Superintendent is further directed to approach Anti-Corruption Establishment for registration of criminal cases against the above-named delinquent ex-officials of Trust.

(PERMISSION FOR SALE OF FALLEN TREES)
(AUCTION OF REED (سارکندا))
(E-TAGGING PROCESS OF LAND)

11. In the last meeting, the committee was constituted for auction of fallen trees. The committee has accomplished the auction process of fallen trees. Report depicts that fallen trees were sold for total sum of Rs.15,75,956/- and an amount of Rs.4,00,000/- was received as earnest money and same has been deposited by the Land Superintendent, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh into the trust account. The committee approved the auction proceedings and directed the successful bidder to deposit remaining amount and thereafter work order will be issued by the Divisional Forest Officer, Muzaffargarh.

12. In the last meeting, it was brought into the notice of the Committee that the reeds (سارکندا) are also available on some portion of the land of SKKT. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh was directed to take care of the said reeds and also make arrangements regarding auction of the same at the earliest. But the report dated 08.12.2025 of Divisional Forest Officer; Muzaffargarh transpires that due to cultivation operations there is no auction able reeds/Sarkanda left at the site of Mouza Dera Kaura. The committee directed the newly appointed field staff to visit the site and submit their report regarding current status/availability of reeds at the land of trust.

13. During the last meeting, the Committee emphasized the need to initiate e-tagging of all trees and lots of the Trust to further enhance transparency, accessibility and effective monitoring of land assets. In this regard, the Divisional Forest Officer, Muzaffargarh, was assigned the responsibility to facilitate the e-tagging process and ensure close coordination with the Assistant Director Agriculture and this office for

timely completion of the task. This agenda was also taken up by the Committee and it was decided that more efforts will be made to accomplish said task by consuming minimum exchequer of the Trust. The newly recruited Revenue Officer/ Tehsildar has been directed by the committee to pursue this matter and submit comprehensive report in the next meeting.

14. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh apprised that despite repeated directions and issuance of notices to the representative of all the concerned Departments qua immediate pursuing the matter regarding recovery of rent and ensure earliest depositing the outstanding rent amount, the same has not yet been deposited. Reminders and detail of outstanding rent had again been issued by the Chairman to the concerned Departments. It is made clear that final opportunity has been given, otherwise, the occupy land shall be evacuated from all the above said Government Departments accordingly.

15. In the previous meeting, it was pointed out by Mr. Muzaffar Hussain Khan Magsi Petitioner of writ petition No.45/1993 that an amount of 10,043,0707/- (100 million) rupees is available with the Local Government of Punjab Account-IV. In this regard Chief Officer, District Council, Muzaffargarh was given the task to approach the quarter concerned for recovery of said amount. The Chief Officer has recently been posted and apprise the Committee he will look into the matter personally, The Committee decided to call the concerned staff of District Council, Muzaffargarh along with relevant record as well. The Chief Officer, District Council, Muzaffargarh stated that the District Council was established on 01.01.2017. Prior to this date, Account-IV was under the administrative and financial control of the Finance Department/District Accounts Officer, Muzaffargarh. Upon the establishment of the District Council, the District Government was dissolved, resulting in the closure of the said account. Since the custodianship of the account rested with the Finance Department, the funds available therein were transferred back to the Finance Department. The details and confirmation of this transfer can be obtained from the District Accounts Officer, Muzaffargarh. The Land Superintendent and Accountant of the Trust are directed to approach the District Accounts Officer's Office, Muzaffargarh for collecting information and record about

16. Mrs. Anam Hafeez ADC (F&P), Muzaffargarh stated that record for preparation of replies of annotated audit paras has not been put up before her by the Record Keeper of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh. The Record Keeper and Accountant of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust have been directed by the Committee to provide the required record (bank statements etc.) without further loss of time so that task, could be accomplished and same may be transmitted to the quarter concerned.

17. In the last meeting the Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur assured the Committee that the amount recovered from the illegal occupants and same shall be deposited into the account of the Sardar Kaura Khan Trust at the earliest, in compliance with legal and administrative requirements. He was directed that a progress report, along with evidence of recovery and deposit, be submitted in the next meeting. The S.S.P Investigation Rajanpur will also assist the Deputy Commissioner in this regard and both the Officers shall ensure the recovery from illegal occupants. No progress has been put up before the Committee by the Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur. Committee directed the Land Superintendent and Tehsildar of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh to approach the office of Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur and SSP Investigation, Rajanpur to proceed further in the matter and submission of report in the next meeting.

20. The Committee perused the recommendations and unanimously approved the names of mentioned supra staff for their appointments. The Committee further made it clear that upon the satisfactory performance and requirements of the Trust their period of appointment may be further extended and pay will also be increased in recognition of up to the mark performance.

AGENDA NO. 11.

(APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY MR. GHULAM RASOOL REGARDING LOT NO. 7, JATOI)

21. Previously, one Ghulam Rasool, leaseholder of lot No.07 Jatoi has moved an application with the version that total lot leased out to him is comprising of 112-Kanals, but he is in possession of only 80-Kanals of land. According to report submitted by the Assistant Commissioner, Jatoi bearing No.1016/AC dated 23.10.2025, the District Council was owner of land measuring 112-Kanals in Khata No.423, Mauza Jatoi Janobi, out of this land, a piece of land measuring 26-Kanals, 16-Marlas has been transferred to T.M.A Jatoi vide mutation No.6133 dated 23.11.2005 by the order of District Officer (Revenue), Muzaffargarh dated 15.09.2005 and the remaining land, now owned by Sardar Kaura Khan Trust in Khata No.423 is 85 Kanal, 04 Marlas. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh was directed to

get transfer the said land in favour of Trust, while cancelling the above-said mutation and then get the possession of said land. The Land Superintendent informed the Committee he has approached the office of Additional Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), Muzaffargarh vide letter No.277/SL dated 06.12.2025 the reply/outcome of which is still awaited. The Land Superintendent also submitted the copy of reminder bearing No.74/SL dated 09.01.2026 on the subject matter. The Committee further directed the Land Superintendent shall continuously pursue the instant matter and shall submit compliance report in the next meeting.

**(APPLICATION MOVED BY MUHAMMAD KASHIF LEASEHOLDER
REGARDING CANCELLATION OF LOT NO.112/1 RAMPUR-I, JATOI**

22. Muhammad Kashif, the leaseholder of Lot No.112/1 has submitted an application stating therein that the entire land of the lot is barren, uninhabited and not cultivable; therefore, his lease agreement of said lot should be cancelled. In this regard report was sought from the Assistant Commissioner, Jatoi who submitted that said lot comprising of 200-K out of which 140-K is cultivable and land measuring 60-K is barren (بے کاشت). The Land Superintendent Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh had been directed to approach the Deputy Director Agriculture, Muzaffargarh to get analysis of soil and water for physical and chemical properties and land suitability for agriculture purposes. Now the Land Superintendent has submitted a copy of the letter bearing No.73/SL dated 09.01.2026 issued in the name of Deputy Director Agriculture, Muzaffargarh stating therein to get analysis of soil and water for physical and chemical properties and land suitability for agriculture purposes. The Committee directed the Land Superintendent to pursue the instant matter and shall submit compliance report in the next meeting.

(APPLICATION OF TEHSIL BAR ASSOCIATION JATOI FOR ALLOTMENT OF LAND)

24. An application has been moved by the Tehsil Bar Association, Jatoi for allotment of land measuring 02-Kanals for parking of motorcycles and cars adjacent with Judicial Lock up and Assistant Commissioner's Office, Jatoi, which is laying vacant. The Tehsil Bar Association, Jatoi also requested that they are ready to pay the lease/rent of said land if the same is allotted to the Bar. In the meeting this agenda was also discussed at length. The Assistant Commissioner, Jatoi apprised the Committee that if the said land is allotted to the Bar Association, Jatoi, the way to Assistant Commissioner's Office, Jatoi will hamper and security situation of the Judicial Lock up will also affected. The Committee decided to post pone this matter till the visit of Chairman Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh.

AGENDA NO.14.

(CANAL WATER FOR LOTS OF SARDAR KAURA KHAN TRUST, LAND)

25. Mr. Muzaffar Hussain Khan Magsi Petitioner of Writ Petition No.45/1993 apprised the Committee that canal water did not reach to the ending point (جگہ), due to which some land of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust could not be cultivated with the canal water. The leaseholders have to arrange other sources for cultivation which enhance their expenses and added their difficulties. In the last meeting the Committee had decided to call the XEN Irrigation/Canal, Muzaffargarh in the next meeting to redress this vital issue of leaseholders/allottees. But in this meeting the Executive Engineer Canal Division, Muzaffargarh did not attend the meeting, however, his representative namely Muhammad Asmar Habib, Deputy Collector Canal

Division, Muzaffargarh came to the office of the undersigned at the end of the meeting. The Committee directed the said representative to inform the XEN Irrigation, Muzaffargarh to attend the next meeting timely to proceed further in the matter.

AGENDA NO.15
(APPROVAL FOR AUCTION OF SKKT LOTS)

26. The Land Superintendent, SKKT Muzaffargarh informed the Committee that on 19.12.2025, 20.12.2025 & 22.12.2025 the Auction Committee completed the auction proceedings of the remaining lots, which could not be auctioned previously. After detailed discussion, the Committee unanimously approved the auction proceedings of auction Committee dated 19.12.2025, 20.12.2025 & 22.12.2025 and directed the Land Superintendent, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh to issue the allotment letter to the aforesaid successful bidder after completion of all requisite codal formalities and to refund the earnest money to the unsuccessful bidders in accordance with law & rules in the shape of cross cheques. The Land Superintendent SKKT, Muzaffargarh was further directed to visit the remaining lots with newly appointed field staff and submit a meticulous report for auction of remaining lots. The Committee laid emphasis that no cultivable land should be left unauctioned. It is further directed that in subsequent auction proceedings, the successful bidder shall deposit the 1/4th of his winning price then & there in addition to the reserve price, he had already deposited. In addition, the Committee also directed the Land Superintend, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh as well as newly appointed field staff to continuously visit the site and ensure that no illegal occupy could be able to cultivate any crop on the land owned by the trust, if so, the same may be confiscated/ captured at the spot.

AGENDA NO.16.

(APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY MR. MUHAMMAD RAFIQUE GUJJAR EX-LAND SUPERINTENDENT SARDAR KAURA KHAN TRUST, MUZAFFARGARH)

27. Mr. Muhammad Raffique Gujjar, Ex-Land Superintendent, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh moved an application before the Chairman to review the decisions taken after regular inquires in connection with fake receipts and embezzlement of trust exchequer. After thorough perusal and detailed discussions, the Committee decided to decline said application because all the prosses has been adopted after due course of inquiry, affording the opportunities of hearing to the applicant.

AGENDA NO.17.**(SCHOOL MATTERS)****(RENOVATION OF SCHOOLS)**
(URGENT NEED FOR STRENGTHENING THE SECURITY MEASURES)

28. The Land Superintendent informed the Committee that he has obtained the following rough cost estimates from the Executive Engineer Buildings, Muzaffargarh of below detailed works.

Keeping in view the prevailing law and order situations across the country as well as delapidated condition of the Schools, the Committee has finally decided that above said work may be executed through the Executive Engineer Buildings, Muzaffargarh after getting open tender by adopting codel formalities in this regard.

29. Similarly, the Committee also decided to hire four Security Guards for Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools, Alipur and Jatoi (02 for each school) from the firm namely Fast Security & Management (SVC), Pvt. Limited, Lahore with the monthly package of Rs.32,000/- per head. Likewise, purchase of Security Cameras and Biometric Attendance Machines for installation at Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools has been approved by the Committee and progress/work completion report shall be evaluated in the next meeting.

30. The Committee has also approved an amount of Rs.50,000/- (fifty thousand only) per month for all the schools of trust i.e. Alipur, Jatoi and Kot Addu, as contingent expenditure for smooth functioning of day-to-day affairs of the schools. In this regard all the Principals/Vice Principals have been directed to utilized the sanctioned funds only in case of genuine and urgent necessity, ensuring transparency. Furthermore, the Principals shall submit detail of expenses along with original receipts on monthly basis to the Accountant of Trust for audit purpose and office record.

31. Keeping in view the prevailing law and order situations across the country, the Management Committee of Sardar Kura Khan Trust has further proposed that razor-cut wire fencing be installed at walls of all schools of Sardar Kura Khan Trust and additional washrooms be

constructed therein. Furthermore, it has been proposed that four classrooms be constructed at Sardar Kura Khan Trust Schools, Alipur and Jatoi, comprising two classrooms on the ground floor and two on the upper floor. For this purpose, a rough cost estimate shall be obtained from the Executive Engineer (Buildings), Muzaffargarh. Accordingly, approval is hereby accorded for carrying out the above-mentioned development works.

32. The Committee further suggested that the Primary Section of Sardar Kaura Khan Public High School, Jatoi, presently located in the main portion of the school, be shifted to another suitable place within the school premises.

33. On request of Land Superintendent Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, for smooth functioning of the trust office, the Management Committee has further approved an amount of Rupees Two Hundred Thousand (Rs.200,000/-) for expenditure of petty nature. The said amount shall remain in the custody of the Land Superintendent, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh who shall utilize it strictly for the day-to-day urgent expenses of the Trust. The Land Superintendent shall ensure transparency, proper maintenance of record, receipts, and accounts of the petty cash expenditure, which shall be subject to audit and review by the competent authority.

(COMPUTER LABS)

34. Requests have also been received from Principals of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools for computer labs for the students of all Schools of the Trust. The Principals of Sardar Kora Khan Trust School, Jatoi, Alipur and Kot Addu are directed to submit a report regarding the number of computers and furniture items in proportion to the number of students. The matter shall be presented in the next meeting for consideration.

35. The Committee also approved the request moved by the Principal, Sardar Kaura Khan School, Kot Addu for purchase of two computer systems.

(INTERNET FACILITY)

36. The Principals of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools, Kot Addu have submitted requests and the estimated cost for installing internet connections. Therefore, the Committee has approved the installation of internet connection in Sardar Koura Khan Schools, Kot Addu and directed the Land Superintendent and Accountant SKKT, Muzaffargarh to do the needful at the earliest.

(REQUEST TO DISPOSE OF IRREPARABLE BROKEN FURNITURE)

37. The Principal, Sardar Kaura Khan School, Jatoi has moved an application to clear out and dispose of a small amount of broken furniture, obsolete equipment and general junk being well beyond economic repair. The Committee directed the Land Superintendent and Principal of said school to adopt necessary step for disposal of said irreparable goods/furniture etc. Similarly, another application has also been moved by the Principal, Sardar Kaura Khan School, Alipur for repair of few furniture items as well as to dispose of irreparable furniture. The same has also been approved by the Committee.

(INCREASE OF SALARY SCHOOL'S STAFF)

38. After discussions the Committee decided to postpone the agenda for increase of salary of school staff till the next meeting of the Trust.

39. The Management Committee also decided to purchase three fire extinguishers cylinders and fire buckets for all Schools of the Trust. Accordingly, approval is granted for the purchase. The said equipment shall be procured for safety and emergency preparedness of trust's schools. The Land Superintendent and Accountant of the Trust are authorized to take necessary steps for procurement and ensure proper installation and record keeping.

40. Mr. Muzaffar Hussain Khan Magsi, the petitioner of Writ Petition No.45/1993, has proposed the initiation of a scholarship program for toper/high marks achievers' children of trust schools as well as position holder of children of Government/Private Schools. Keeping in view, the will of great Sardar Kaura Khan late, the Management Committee of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, has decided to introduce a Scholarship Program under the auspices of the Trust. In this regard, the Deputy Commissioner, Muzaffargarh has been assigned the task to prepare and submit a detailed report covering the scope, eligibility criteria, estimated financial implications and implementation mechanism of the said proposed scholarship program. The report shall be presented in the next meeting of the Management Committee for consideration and final approval.

ESTABLISHMENT OF NURSING COLLEGE AND POLYTECHNIC INSTITUTE)

41. The District & Sessions Judge/Chairman Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh proposed that in view of Will of Sardar Kaura Khan late to impart education to the masses of locality to establish Nursing College and Polytechnic Institute. In this regard the Deputy Commissioner, Muzaffargarh

has been assigned the task to submit proposals for establishment of said Institute in the up coming meeting.






