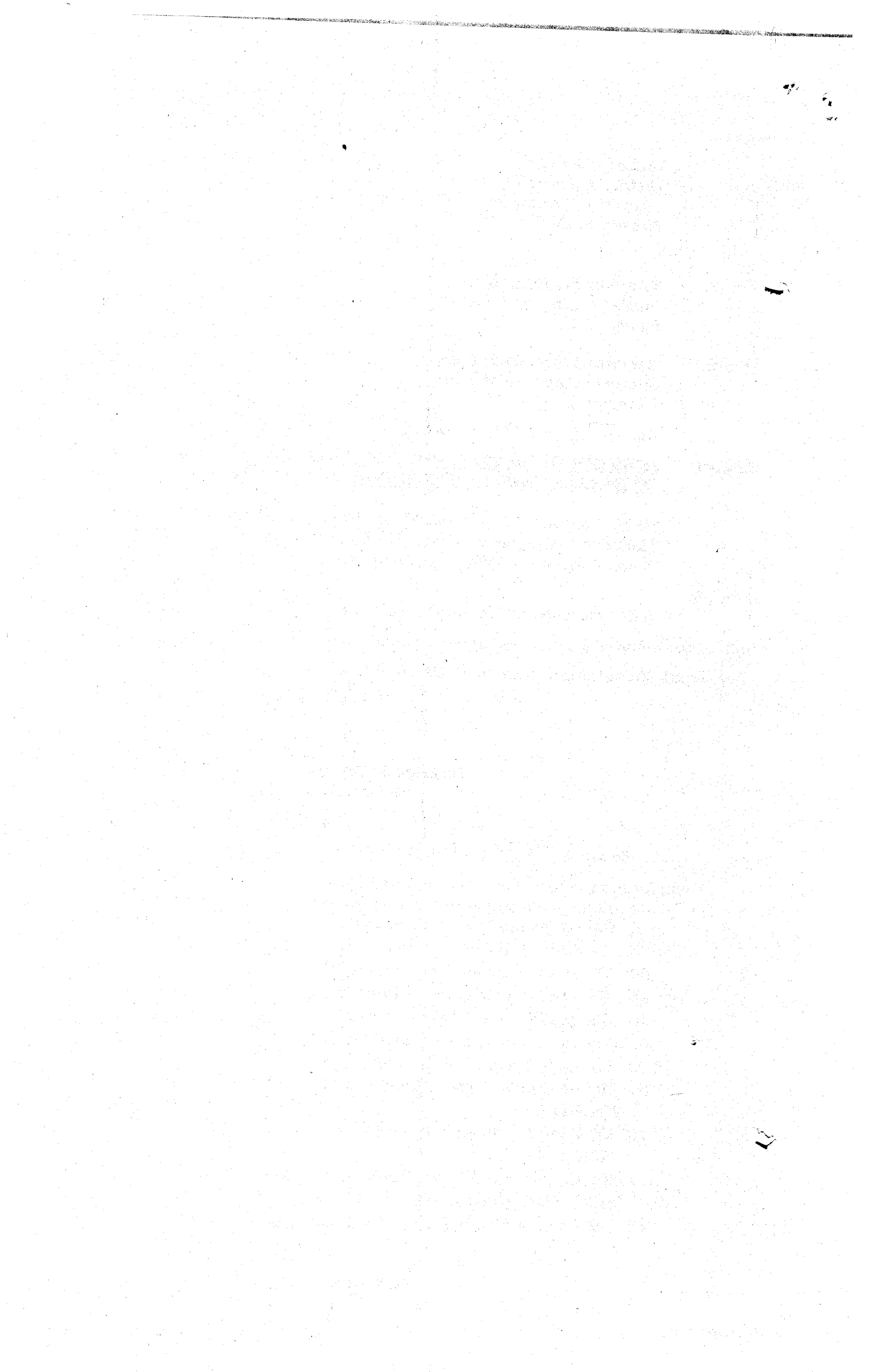

MINUTES OF MEETING OF MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE OF SARDAR KAURA KHAN TRUST (REGISTERED), MUZAFFARGARH HELD ON 19.02.2026 AT 12:30 P.M UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE/CHAIRMAN SARDAR KAURA KHAN TRUST, MUZAFFARGARH.

In pursuance of Rule 4 Sub rule 2 of the Notification No. SOR-(LG)38-24/2015 dated 04.03.2016; a meeting of the Management Committee of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh was convened on 19.02.2026 at 12:30 P:M under the Chairmanship of the District and Sessions Judge/Chairman Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh. The members mentioned at Sr. No.01 of Para 02 did not attend the meeting in person, rather Mr. Muhammad Ashraf, S.S.P Investigation, Rajanpur attended the meeting on his behalf and Mr. Muhammad Waqas Gujjar, Chief Officer, District Council, Muzaffargarh also did not attend the meeting in person due to his appearance before the Hon'ble Lahore High Court, Multan Bench, Multan, rather he was represented by Mr. Muhammad Zohaib Habib Qureshi, District Officer (Finance), District Council, Muzaffargarh.

4. The members mentioned at Sr. No.02 & 03 of Para 02 did not attend the meeting and remained absent from the meeting without prior intimation. The Committee formally recorded its displeasure regarding the said absence.

6. Mr. Muzaffar Hussain Khan Magsi, petitioner of HRC No.45/1993 and Mr. Muhammad Anwar Khan Sherwani Advocate, Legal Advisor Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh have also attended the meeting on special invitation.

7. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh has also attended the meeting.

8. The Chair welcomed all participants and members of the Management Committee. The agenda items were taken up for discussion, and the following decisions were unanimously/accordingly made.

(AGENDA NO.01)
(PROGRESS OF RECOVERY STATUS FROM LEASE HOLDERS)

9. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh apprised the Committee that an amount of **Rs.1,11,87,230/-** has been recovered from the leaseholders and defaulters w.e.f. 21.01.2026 to 18.02.2026 of Kharif Crop.

10. The Committee emphasized that strict and effective follow-up be carried out with all leaseholders and defaulters for the recovery of outstanding dues. The Land Superintendent and Tehsildar, SKKT, Muzaffargarh, were directed to adopt all necessary legal and administrative measures in this regard, strictly in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations. They were further instructed to intensify recovery efforts and closely monitor progress, particularly in view of the recent provision of additional field staff to support the recovery process. The Revenue Officer and field staff were also directed to ensure that no allottee shall be permitted to harvest or remove crops from the leased land unless and until a clearance certificate/letter, duly issued by this office after deposit of the outstanding lease amount, is produced. In case of continued default, appropriate action under the relevant lease conditions shall be initiated and a detailed progress report shall be submitted in the next meeting.

(AGENDA NO.02)**INITIATION OF STEPS TAKEN AGAINST THE EX-LAND SUPERINTENDENT, SKKT, MUZAFFARGARH AND EX-RECOVERY CLERK IN PURSUANCE OF INQUIRY REPORTS SUBMITTED BY MR. GHULAM SHABBIR HUSSAIN, LEARNED ADDITIONAL DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE, JATOI).**

11. The progress report with regard to recovery of embezzled amount, initiation of departmental proceedings and registration of criminal cases at Anticorruption Establishment (Circle Office), Muzaffargarh against Muhammad Raffique Gujjar, Ex-Land Superintendent and Muhammad Raza Imran, Ex-Recovery Clerk, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh was also reviewed.

12. Mr. Ashfaq Hussain Tarin, Land Superintendent, Sardar Kora Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh informed the Committee that a case FIR No. 10/26 has been registered with the Anti-Corruption Establishment, Muzaffargarh, against Muhammad Rafiq Gujjar Ex-Land Superintendent and Muhammad Raza Imran Ex-Recovery Clerk. Muhammad Rafiq Gujjar has surrendered, while the remaining 49 complaints have been sent to the Director, Anti-Corruption, Dera Ghazi Khan, for registration of FIRs. The Committee directed to Mr. Ashfaq Hussain Tareen, Land Superintendent, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh that all pending complaints should be processed for registration of case at the earliest in accordance with law. Further, legal proceedings against Muhammad Raza Imran should be diligently followed up with the relevant authorities to ensure proper and lawful action. A progress report in this regard shall be submitted in the next meeting.

AGENDA NO.03**(AUCTION OF CATTAIL PLANTS (۲۴) AND ACACIA TREE PLANTS (۳))****(AUCTION OF REED (۲۴))****(E-TAGGING PROCESS OF LAND)**

13. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Muzaffargarh was invited in the meeting but did not attend. In his place, Mr. Shafqat Ali, Forest Protection Officer, Khanpur, attended the meeting. Regarding the auction of Cattail Plants (۲۴) and Acacia Tree Plants (۳), the Forest Protection Officer, Khanpur reported that the auction was scheduled to be held on 18.02.2026 at the Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, office Jatoi. An advertisement had also been published in the newspapers; however, only six individuals appeared before the committee for bidding. These attendees declined to participate in the auction, stating that they had not visited the Cattail Plants (۲۴) and Acacia Tree Plants (۳) at lot Nos. 40 to 45 and were therefore unaware of the quantity. As a result, the auction

could not be successfully conducted. Mr. Shafqat Ali, Forest Protection Officer, Khanpur informed the committee, vide Letter No. 93 dated 18.02.2026. Hence, Deputy Conservator of Forest, Muzaffargarh was accordingly directed to proceed further in accordance to law.

14. The Committee emphasized the need to initiate e-tagging of all trees and lots of the Trust to further enhance transparency, accessibility and effective monitoring of land assets. In this regard, the Deputy Conservator of Forest, Muzaffargarh, Ashfaq Hussain Tareen, Land Superintendent and Mehr Zafar Hussain, Record Keeper along with the field staff of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh were directed to carry out the e-tagging of trees and the respective lots.

15. The Committee directed the Land Superintendent and Accountant, SKKT, Muzaffargarh to issue further notices and take all necessary measures to ensure the recovery of rent for the buildings and occupied land without delay. It was made clear that this constitutes the final opportunity; in case of non-compliance, the occupied land/buildings shall be evocated by all the above-mentioned Government Departments, as per applicable rules and procedures.

(BALANCE AMOUNT OF RS.100 MILLION AVAILABLE WITH THE LOCAL GOVT. OF PUNJAB IN ACCOUNT-IV, CMA NO.5837/16 OUTSTANDING AMOUNT OF TRUST PAGE 06 TO 07 AND INQUIRY REPORT OF WORTHY DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE, DATED 10.07.2015 PAGE NO.18)

16. In the previous meeting, the Land Superintendent and Accountant of the Trust were directed to approach the District Accounts Officer's Office, Muzaffargarh for collecting information and record about the above quoted amount available in Account-IV under the supervision of Chief Officer, District Council, Muzaffargarh. It was noted that the Secretary, Local Government and Community Development Department/ Representative, and Chief Officer, District Council, Muzaffargarh did not attend the meeting, due to which no action could be taken regarding Account-IV. The Chairman, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh expressed displeasure over this absence. Furthermore, the District Accounts Officer, Muzaffargarh, has not

submitted the pending old records. The Land Superintendent and Accountant of the Trust were directed to issue reminder and ensure that a final report is presented to the Management Committee, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh in the next meeting.

(PROPOSED ANNOTATED REPLY OF AUDIT PARAS)
(WITHHOLDING TAX EXAMPTION CERTIFICATE)

17. The Deputy Commissioner, Muzaffargarh stated that replies of 10 Audit Paras related to Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh have been prepared and submitted to the concerned quarter. He further stated that the relevant papers for issuance of Tax Exemption Certificate have been deposited with the Income Tax Office, Multan and it is expected that the Tax Exemption Certificate will be issued shortly. The Committee appreciated the efforts of the Deputy Commissioner, Muzaffargarh and expected that the assigned tasks be completed at the earliest and a final report is presented to the Management Committee in the next meeting.

(APPLICATION REGARDING ILLEGAL OCCUPANT AT LOT NO.01 & 02,
MAUZA NOORPUR, TEHSIL RAJANPUR)

18. In the last meeting the Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur assured the Committee that the amount recovered from the illegal occupants and same shall be deposited into the account of the Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh at the earliest, in compliance with legal and administrative requirements. It was noted that no action has been taken by the Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur. The Committee directed that a letter be issued to the Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur, instructing him with the assistance of PERA-forces, evict the illegal occupants/ encroachers from Lot No. 01, Raqba Naseer and Lot No. 02, Mauza Noorpur, Tehsil Rajanpur, and recover the outstanding dues to be deposited in the accounts of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh. The Committee expressed its displeasure over the inaction of the Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur in this matter. Committee further directed the Land Superintendent, Tehsildar and concerned Patwari of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh to approach the office of Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur and SSP Investigation, Rajanpur to proceed further in the matter and submission of report in the next meeting.

AGENDA NO.08.

(APPLICATION OF TEHSIL BAR ASSOCIATION JATOI FOR ALLOTMENT
OF 02K-00M LAND FOR CAR/MOTORCYCLE PARKING)

19. In the last meeting of the Management Committee of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, an application was submitted by the Tehsil Bar Association, Jatoi, requesting the allotment of 02-Kanals of vacant land

adjacent to the Judicial Lock-up and the Assistant Commissioner's Office, Jatoi, for parking of motorcycles and cars. In light of the objections raised by the Assistant Commissioner, Jatoi, in the previous meeting, the matter was deliberated upon in detail by the Committee. After careful consideration, the Committee resolved to defer the agenda item until the next meeting.

AGENDA NO.09.

(APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY MR. GHULAM RASOOL REGARDING LOT NO.7, JATOI)

20. In the previous meeting, the Land Superintendent informed the Committee that he had approached the office of the Additional Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), Muzaffargarh, vide Letter No.277/SL dated 06.12.2025 and a reminder No.74/SL dated 09.01.2026; the reply/outcome of which is still awaited. The Committee directed that the Additional Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), Muzaffargarh, personally look into the matter and resolve it at the earliest, submitting his report to the office. The Committee further directed the Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh, to personally visit the office of the Additional Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), Muzaffargarh to assist him in this matter and pursue its resolution. A compliance report shall be submitted by the Land Superintendent in the next meeting.

(APPLICATION MOVED BY MUHAMMAD KASHIF LEASEHOLDER REGARDING CANCELLATION OF LOT NO.112/1 RAMPUR-I, JATOI)

21. In the previous meeting of Management Committee, the Land Superintendent, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh had been directed to approach the Deputy Director Agriculture, Muzaffargarh to get analysis of soil and water for physical and chemical properties and land suitability for agriculture purposes. Now the Deputy Director Agriculture, Muzaffargarh, in his report submitted via letter No.105 dated 11.02.2026, stated that for the specified lot, application of gypsum, manure, and green fertilizer is required to make the land suitable for cultivation. The Committee directed the Land Superintendent, Tehsildar and Accountant of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh that an estimate be prepared regarding the approximate cost of these inputs to facilitate further planning and shall submit compliance report in the upcoming meeting.

AGENDA NO.10.

(APPLICATION REGARDING VARIOUS LOTS, THE AREA IS LESS, OR THE LAND IS BARREN AND RIVER-ERODED (دریائی دہل) LOTS NO.157/1, 164/1, 171/1 MOUZA RAMPUR-III, 88/1 MOUZA RAMPUR-I, TEHSIL JATOI AND LOTS NO.01,07,15 MOUZA SAIDPUR, TEHSIL JAMPUR)

22. The Tehsildar, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, reported that the above-mentioned lots are barren riverine land (دریائی دہل), which

requires adjustment in the land auction amount. The Committee decided that the Tehsildar, SKKT, Muzaffargarh should prepare an estimate in accordance with the auction rates. The Committee further decided that the payable amount should be reduced proportionately, granting the allottees a concession due to the riverine and barren nature of the land. A compliance report shall be submitted by the Tehsildar Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh in the next meeting.

(ILLEGAL OCCUPANTS LOTS OF SARDAR KAURA KHAN TRUST)

23. It was reported that the Assistant Commissioner/SDEO PERA-Force, Jatoi, has not yet evicted the illegal occupants/encroachers from the above-mentioned lots. The Committee decided that all the matters be referred to Mr. Ghulam Shabbir Hussain, learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Jatoi, for thorough investigation. Where necessary, the Police/PERA-Force should be assisted to ensure eviction, and a detailed report of the action taken should be submitted to this office at the earliest.

(CANAL WATER FOR LOTS OF SKKT LANDS)

24. The Executive Engineer, Canal Division, Muzaffargarh, was invited in the meeting but did not attend. In his place, Chaudhry Abdul Rasheed, HVC, Canal Division, Muzaffargarh, attended the meeting. It was reported that water from the Trust's lots is being illegally diverted, while the Canal Department has not taken any action in this regard. The Committee directed that FIRs be registered for the theft of water and that arrangements be also made to ensure uninterrupted water supply to the lots of Sardar Kuara Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh in the coming days.

(RENOVATION OF SCHOOLS)

(URGENT NEED FOR STRENGTHENING THE SECURITY MEASURES)

26. In the previous meeting, the following rough cost estimates of the below detailed work were prepared and submitted by the Executive Engineer (Buildings), Muzaffargarh.

The tender fee for the above-mentioned work has been deposited with PPRA, Lahore and further proceedings will be carried out in the next meeting of the Management Committee upon receipt of the tenders.

(ESTABLISHMENT OF NURSING COLLEGE)

27. In the last meeting of Management Committee the Chairman Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh proposed that in view of Will of Sardar Kaura Khan late to impart education to the masses of locality to establish Nursing College. In this regard, formal letters have been addressed to the higher authorities of Indus Hospital & Health Network, requesting them to submit comprehensive proposals in light of their institutional experience and professional expertise. Their response is still awaited.

Similarly, Agha Khan University, Karachi, has also been approached for the same purpose; however, no reply has been received from their side to date. Upon receipt of a response from Indus Hospital & Health Network, the matter shall be placed before the next meeting for consideration and further necessary action.

(MERIT BASED SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR TALENTED AND DESERVING STUDENTS)

28. In the previous meeting of Management Committee Mr. Muzaffar Hussain Khan Magsi, the petitioner of HRC No.45/1993, has proposed the initiation of a scholarship program for toper/high marks achievers' children of Trust schools as well as position holder of children of Government/Private Schools of District Muzaffargarh. In this regard, the Management Committee resolved to constitute a committee comprising of following eminent education experts:

29. The above-said Committee shall finalize the proposed draft aimed at establishing a transparent, merit-based, and need-sensitive framework for awarding scholarships to needy, deserving, and meritorious students of District Muzaffargarh, covering educational support from early years to higher and professional education. The proposed draft shall thereafter be placed before the Management Committee in its next meeting for consideration and appropriate decision.

30. The Management Committee, SKKT, Muzaffargarh also approved that two brilliant students of Sardar Kaura Khan Public School, Jatoi, Sunryab Fatima daughter of Barat Hussain Jatoi and Ruqia Sadiq daughter of Sadiq Hussain have successfully passed their 9th and 10th class annual examinations for the year-2025 respectively, with distinguished marks. In recognition of their achievement and keep such passion in future, both the students are awarded a scholarship/prize of Rs.50,000/- (rupees fifty thousand only) each by the Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh.

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(COMPUTER LABS AND I.T & OFFICE EQUIPMENT)

31. In the last meeting of the Management Committee, requests were received from the Principals of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools for the establishment of computer laboratories in all Trust schools. In this regard, Mr. Tahir Bashir, Principal, Sardar Kaura Khan School, Muzaffargarh/Director, Trust Schools, is hereby directed to submit a comprehensive report, clearly specifying the required number of computers, necessary furniture, and all other relevant details for the establishment of the computer labs, so that the matter may be placed before the next meeting for consideration and appropriate decision.

32. Mr. Tahir Bashir/Director School Affairs/Member Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh has further submitted consolidated demand and comparative statement for procurement of I.T & Office equipment for Trust School, Kot Addu, Alipur and Jatoi. The Land Superintendent and Accountant of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh has been directed to proceed further in the instant matter and procure said I.T & office equipments in accordance with relevant rules and put up report in the next meeting.

(I.T/COMPUTER TEACHER IN ALL SKKT SCHOOLS)

33. Since the Management Committee has duly approved the establishment of computer laboratories in all schools of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, it was further resolved in the same meeting that one (01) I.T/Computer Teacher be appointed for each school. The appointed I.T/Computer Teacher shall be responsible not only for imparting computer education to students but also for the proper management and maintenance of the respective computer laboratory. Accordingly, the Trust office is hereby directed to initiate the recruitment process forthwith, including the publication of advertisement in leading newspapers and completion of all codal and procedural formalities, so that the required I.T/Computer Teachers may be appointed at the earliest.

(FURNITURE FOR SCHOOL)

34. Mr. Tahir Bashir/Director School Affairs/Member Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh has submitted consolidated demand and comparative statement for procurement of furniture of Trust Schools, Kot Addu, Alipur and Jatoi. The Land Superintendent and Accountant of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh has been directed to proceed further in the instant matter and procure said furniture articles in accordance with relevant rules and put up compliance report in the next meeting.

(INTERNET FACILITY)

35. In the previous meeting of the Management Committee, the Principals of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools, Kot Addu, submitted request along with the estimated cost for the installation of internet connection. The internet connection has since been installed, and all associated charges have been duly paid.

(CCTVS SECURITY CAMERAS)

36. The Principal, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust School, Kot Addu, submitted a request drawing attention to the urgent need of security cameras for strengthening the security arrangements of the school. In view of the prevailing security situation across the country and considering the sensitivity of educational institutions, the Committee thoroughly deliberated on the matter and unanimously approved the request of the said principal. The Land Superintendent and Accountant of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh has been directed to proceed further in the instant matter and procure said security cameras in accordance with relevant rules and put up compliance report in the next meeting

(AUCTION OF CANTEENS OF SKKT, SCHOOLS)

37. The Management Committee has proposed that the canteens of SKKT Schools, Alipur, Jatoi, and Kot Addu be put to open auction. In this regard, it is recommended that an advertisement be published in the local newspapers, and all concerned Principals be directed to determine the designated space for the canteen and make the necessary arrangements to facilitate the auction process.

(EPA SMART WASTE CERTIFIED IN ALL SCHOOLS OF SKKT)

38. The Management Committee deliberated upon order No. 316/PA to DG/EPA/2025 dated 18.08.2025 issued by the Government of Punjab, Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), regarding mandatory waste segregation in all public and private educational institutions. After detailed discussion, it was unanimously decided that all Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools located at Alipur, Jatoi and Kot Addu shall immediately procure and install five color-coded dustbins in accordance with the EPA directives: -

- a) **Yellow Bin - Paper waste**
(paper, cartons, office paper, packaging material)
- b) **Green Bin - Glass waste**
(bottles, jars, broken glass items, laboratory glassware)
- c) **Grey Bin - Organic/Biodegradable waste**
(food scraps, fruit peels, leaves, garden waste)
- d) **Red Bin - Metal waste**
(aluminum cans, tins, foils, small scrap)
- e) **Orange Bin - Plastic waste**
(wrappers, bottles, disposable cutlery, bags)

39. The Committee further directed that the said bins be placed at appropriate and visible locations within the School premises and that awareness sessions be also conducted to educate staff and students on proper waste disposal practices to ensure environmental protection and compliance with the said order.

**(TRANSFER OF LAND OF ZILA COUNCIL, MUZAFFARGARH TO THE
SARDAR KAURA KHAN PUBLIC SCHOOL FREE OF COST)**

40. Mr. Muzaffar Hussain Khan Magsi, the petitioner of HRC No.45/1993, informed the Management Committee that 37-Kanals of land belonging to the Zila Council, Muzaffargarh have been transferred unlawfully in the name of Sardar Kaura Khan School, Muzaffargarh. The Management Committee has therefore decided that the Additional Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), Muzaffargarh, be directed to submit a detailed report on this matter, which must, in any case, be presented before or in the next meeting.

41. The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks extended to all the participants, expressing appreciation for their attendance, contributions and able assistance.
