In pursuance of Rule 4 Sub rule 2 of the Notification No.SOR-(LG)38-24/2015 dated 04.03.2016; a meeting of the Management Committee of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh was convened on 12.03.2026 at 12:30 P:M under the Chairmanship of the District and Sessions Judge/Chairman Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh. 4. The member mentioned at Sr. No.01 of Para 03 did not attend the meeting in person, rather Mr. Nasir Mehmood, S.P Investigation, Muzaffargarh attended the meeting on his behalf.

5. Mr. Saeed Ullah Gasoora, President District Bar Association, Muzaffargarh mentioned at Sr. No.02 of Para No.03 did not attend the meeting and remained absent from the meeting without any intimation. The Committee formally recorded its displeasure regarding his absence.

6. The Additional Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), Muzaffargarh was also invited to participate in the meeting for their valuable assistance and support.

7. The Land Superintendent and Tehsildar SKKT, Muzaffargarh have also attended the meeting.

8. The Chair welcomed all participants and members of the Management Committee. The agenda items were taken up for discussion, and the following decisions were unanimously/accordingly made.

**(AGENDA NO.01)**

**(PROGRESS OF RECOVERY STATUS FROM LEASE HOLDERS)**

9. The Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh apprised the Committee that an amount of **Rs.72,51,637/-** has been recovered from the leaseholders and defaulters w.e.f. 20.02.2026 to 11.03.2026 of Kharif Crop.

10. The Committee emphasized that the recovery for the Sardar Kaura Khan Trust lots during this period has remained extremely low. In view of this unsatisfactory performance, **recovery officials are hereby directed to show immediate improvement in their duties.** All field staff are strictly instructed to make every possible effort to enhance both past and current recovery of the Trust. Maximum outstanding dues must be recovered from the allottees without delay. Necessary legal and administrative actions should be taken, wherever required to ensure compliance. This matter must be treated with utmost seriousness, so that the Trust does not suffer any financial loss in the future and no excessive outstanding liabilities remain against the allottees. **In case of continued default, appropriate action under the relevant lease conditions should be initiated against lease holders and a detailed progress report shall be submitted in the next meeting by the field staff.**

**(AGENDA NO.02)**

**INITIATION OF STEPS TAKEN AGAINST THE EX-LAND SUPERINTENDENT, SARDAR KAUR KHAN TRUST, MUZAFFARGARH AND EX-RECOVERY CLERK IN PURSUANCE OF INQUIRY REPORTS SUBMITTED BY MR. GHULAM SHABBIR HUSSAIN, LEARNED ADDITIONAL DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE, JATOI.**

11. The progress report with regard to recovery of embezzled amount, initiation of departmental proceedings and registration of criminal cases at Anticorruption Establishment (Circle Office), Muzaffargarh against Muhammad Raffique Gujjar, Ex-Land Superintendent and Muhammad Raza Imran, Ex-Recovery Clerk, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh was also reviewed.

12. The Management Committee has directed the Land Superintendent, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh to personally meet with the Regional Director, Anti-Corruption Establishment, Dera Ghazi Khan,

in this regard. Furthermore, a separate official letter should also be issued to the said office requesting that maximum recovery be ensured at the earliest. The matter regarding the arrest of Muhammad Raza Imran, Recovery Clerk, should also be vigorously pursued, so that he may be apprehended and the outstanding amount recovered from him, thereby making good the financial loss caused to the Trust. Necessary efforts and legal measures must be taken without delay to protect the interests of the Trust and to ensure full recovery of the dues. A progress report in this regard shall be submitted in the next meeting.

**AGENDA NO.03**

**(AUCTION OF CATTAIL PLANTS (گند) AND ACACIA TREE PLANTS (گج))**

**(AUCTION OF REED (گند))**

**(E-TAGGING PROCESS OF LAND)**

13. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Muzaffargarh, did not attend the meeting in person; however, Auction Committee submitted a written report/bid sheet. In the said report, it has been informed that despite publishing the advertisement in newspapers twice and repeatedly conducting the auction proceedings, no individual or party has shown willingness to take Cattail Plants (گند) and Acacia Tree Plants (گج). Consequently, the auction could not be successfully completed. In view of this situation, the Committee proposed that the matter be deferred for the time being.

14. The Deputy Conservator of Forest, Muzaffargarh, was previously directed to carry out e-tagging of the trees located on the land of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust and to submit a detailed report. However, he has failed to treat the matter with due seriousness, and to date, no e-tagging has been carried out. As a result, trees belonging to the Trust are being unlawfully removed/thefted and no proper record is being maintained. Therefore, the Deputy Conservator of Forest, Muzaffargarh, is hereby directed to ensure, prior to the next meeting, the numbering of all standing (green) trees and the counting of all dry and fallen trees on SKKT land and to submit a comprehensive report accordingly. Strict compliance is hereby directed.

**(AGENDA NO.04)**

**(RECOVERY OF RENT OF GOVT. BUILDINGS)**

15. The Committee expressed serious dissatisfaction over the lack of any tangible progress in the recovery of rent for the buildings and occupied land. The Land Superintendent, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, is hereby directed to immediately issue formal notices to the concerned Government Departments, requiring them to either clear all outstanding dues up to March 2026 without further delay or vacate the occupied buildings. **This directive must be treated as a final notice.** In the event of non-compliance, necessary action shall be initiated to have the buildings vacated in accordance with the applicable rules and procedures, so that the said properties may be rented out to other interested individuals or companies. The Committee emphasized that the current situation is causing significant financial loss to the Trust and cannot be allowed to continue any further.

**(AGENDA NO.05)**

**(BALANCE AMOUNT OF RS.100 MILLION AVAILABLE WITH THE LOCAL GOVT. OF PUNJAB IN ACCOUNT-IV, CMA NO.5837/16 OUTSTANDING AMOUNT OF TRUST PAGE 06 TO 07 AND INQUIRY REPORT OF WORTHY DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE, DATED 10.07.2015 PAGE NO.18)**

16. Mr. Saeed Ahmad Khan, Deputy Secretary, LG & CD, Lahore, informed the Committee that no record regarding Account-IV of District Muzaffargarh is available in his office. He further stated that the relevant record is likely to be available in the District Accounts Office, Muzaffargarh, and may be traced out from there. The District Accounts Officer, Muzaffargarh, had also been invited to attend the meeting; however, he did not appear despite having been formally notified through a letter requesting him to present the complete record pertaining to Account-IV. Unfortunately, the said record was not produced. In view of this situation, the Committee decided that a reminder be issued to the District Accounts Officer, Muzaffargarh, directing him to ensure that the relevant record is traced and presented in the next meeting so that the matter may be properly resolved.

17. During the meeting, Mr. Muhammad Anwar Khan Sherwani, Advocate, Legal Advisor to Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, informed the Committee that all the funds previously lying in Account-IV relating to Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh had already been transferred to the Trust's account. He further assured the Committee that he would trace the relevant record and present it in the next meeting.

**AGENDA NO.06.**

**(APPLICATION OF TEHSIL BAR ASSOCIATION JATOI FOR ALLOTMENT OF 02K-00M LAND FOR CAR/MOTORCYCLE PARKING)**

18. An application was received from the Tehsil Bar Association, Jatoi, requesting that 02 Kanals of land, intended for parking and situated adjacent to the Bakhshi Khana, Sessions Courts, Jatoi, be rented out to the Tehsil Bar Association, Jatoi. Upon obtaining information from various sources and conducting the necessary assessment, it has been observed that if the said 02 Kanal land is rented out for parking purposes, the passage would be blocked, which may lead to security concerns. In view of these circumstances, the request is hereby declined.

**(AGENDA NO.07)**

**(APPLICATION REGARDING ILLEGAL OCCUPANT AT LOT NO.01 & 02, MAUZA NOORPUR, TEHSIL RAJANPUR)**

19. A letter No. 398/SKKT dated 05.03.2024 was sent to the Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur, requesting action to recover land from the encroachers and to recover the outstanding lease amount, as well as to facilitate the transfer of the land. The Deputy Commissioner, Rajanpur, informed the Committee that a significant portion of the land has already been recovered and that some lease amounts have also been collected. Further, recovery from the leaseholders and the encroachers is ongoing. The Committee appreciated these efforts and directed that the remaining land and lease recovery be carried out promptly.

**AGENDA NO.08.**

**(APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY MR. GHULAM RASOOL REGARDING LOT NO.7, JATOI)**

20. Mr. Awaid Irshad Bhatti, Additional Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), Muzaffargarh, informed the Committee that a reference has been sent to the Member of the Colonies Board of Revenue, Lahore, regarding Lot No. 07, Mouza Jatoi Janoobi, Transfer No. 6133 dated 23.11.2025, and the encroachment case against Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, through Letter No. 56/HCC dated 23.02.2026, seeking guidelines on the matter. Upon receipt of a response, further action will be taken as required.

**AGENDA NO.09.**

**(APPLICATION MOVED BY MUHAMMAD KASHIF LEASEHOLDER REGARDING CANCELLATION OF LOT NO.112/1 RAMPUR-I, JATOI)**

21. According to the test report dated 11.02.2026, under letter No.528/SKKT dated 10.03.2026, the Deputy Director Agriculture, Muzaffargarh, was requested to submit an estimated report on a per-acre basis. Since the report has not yet been received, the Land Superintendent, SKKT, Muzaffargarh, is hereby directed to coordinate with the relevant office to obtain the estimated report so that the matter may be resolved.

**AGENDA NO.10.**

**(APPLICATION REGARDING VARIOUS LOTS, THE AREA IS LESS, OR THE LAND IS BARREN AND RIVER-ERODED (دریائی دہل) LOTS NO.157/1, 164/1, 171/1 MOUZA RAMPUR-III, 88/1 MOUZA RAMPUR-I, TEHSIL JATOI AND LOTS NO.01,07,15 MOUZA SAIDPUR, TEHSIL JAMPUR)**

22. The Committee decided that the payable amount should be reduced proportionately, granting the allottees a concession due to the riverine and barren nature of the land. It was noted that no report on this matter has been received from the Tehsildar Jatoi and the Tehsildar SKKT, Muzaffargarh. Therefore, both are again directed to submit their comprehensive reports at the earliest so that relief may be granted to the allottees.

**AGENDA NO.11.**

**(ILLEGAL OCCUPANTS LOTS OF SARDAR KAURA KHAN TRUST)**

a. Lot No. 03, 26, 27 & 28 Mouza Jatoi Shumali.

b. 35 Nos. lots of Mouza Daira Kaura

23. The matters concerning the above-mentioned lots of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, are currently pending before Mr. Ghulam Shabir Hussain, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Jatoi. Despite the passage of considerable time, no decision has yet been rendered and the related compliance report has not been submitted. In order to ensure the timely resolution of these issues and to uphold the principles of efficiency and accountability, it is respectfully urged that Mr. Ghulam Shabir Hussain, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Jatoi, be directed to decide the pending matters within one month.

**AGENDA NO.12.**

**(CANAL WATER FOR LOTS OF SKKT LANDS)**

24. As per Canal Authorities from April 2026, the canal water will begin flowing. Therefore, the Land Superintendent and Tehsildar, SKKT, Muzaffargarh, are directed to closely monitor the lots of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, with regard to water supply. They should verify that the lots adjacent to the irrigation canal are receiving water as intended. In case of any issues, they must immediately coordinate with the XEN Canal, Muzaffargarh to ensure uninterrupted water supply to these lots. A clear and satisfactory report regarding the status of water distribution must be submitted at the next meeting.

**AGENDA NO.13.**

**(TRANSFER OF LAND OF ZILA COUNCIL, MUZAFFARGARH TO THE SARDAR KAURA KHAN PUBLIC SCHOOL FREE OF COST)**

25. Previously, Mr. Muzaffar Hussain Khan Magsi, the petitioner of HRC No. 45/1993, had informed the Management Committee that 37

Kanals of land belonging to the Zila Council, Muzaffargarh, had been unlawfully transferred in the name of Sardar Kaura Khan School, Muzaffargarh. In this regard, the Additional Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), Muzaffargarh, submitted a letter concerning the aforementioned land (letter No. 195/NTO dated 09.03.2026) to the Deputy Secretary (General), Government of Punjab, Local Government & Rural Development, Lahore. The letter requested verification of the relevant records and sought further guidelines. A response is still awaited. Upon receipt of the reply from the Deputy Secretary (General), appropriate action will be taken.

**AGENDA NO.14.**

**(PAYMENTS OF BILLS)**

26. The Accountant of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Muzaffargarh has reported that a photo state bill of Rs.14157/- is outstanding for the month of February-2026. The Committee has approved the payment of these bills.

**AGENDA NO.15.**

**(HIRING OF LABOUR FOR WHEAT CROP SEASONS)**

27. The wheat season is about to commence on the land of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh. However, several allottees have not deposited the required auction amount, while some illegal occupants have unlawfully cultivated crops on the Trust's land. In order to prevent potential loss to the Trust and to safeguard the standing crops, the Management Committee has proposed that, on a temporary basis for the wheat season, security guards be deployed through reputable security agencies. In this regard, the Chief Officer, District Council Muzaffargarh/ Secretary, Management Committee Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, is directed to immediately contact security companies to obtain details regarding the provision of security guards, including their monthly remuneration, payment terms, and other related matters, and submit a comprehensive report. This will enable the authorities to complete the process at the earliest and ensure effective protection of the crops belonging to Sardar Kaura Khan Trust.

**AGENDA NO.16.**

**(REQUEST FOR PURCHASE OF 05 MOTORCYCLES FOR PATWARIS AND RECOVERY PERSONNELS)**

28. The Management Committee decided and again directed the Accountant, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh is directed to obtain quotations from the market for purchase of 05-Nos new Honda CG-125 Motorcycles for Patwaris and Recovery Personnels of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh.

**AGENDA NO.17.****(SCHOOL MATTERS)****(RENOVATION OF SCHOOLS)****(URGENT NEED FOR STRENGTHENING THE SECURITY MEASURES)**

29. In the previous meeting, the following rough cost estimates of the works detailed below were prepared and submitted by the Executive Engineer (Buildings), Muzaffargarh:

The tender fee for the above-mentioned works has been deposited with PPRA, Lahore, and the tenders have already been floated. The date for opening of the tenders has been fixed as **18.03.2026**. After the opening of the tenders, further proceedings will be initiated accordingly, and necessary orders regarding the execution of the works will be issued.

**(ESTABLISHMENT OF NURSING COLLEGE)**

30. In the last meeting of the Management Committee, the Chairman of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, proposed that, in accordance with the will of the late Sardar Kaura Khan to promote and impart education among the people of the locality, a **Nursing College** should be established under the Trust. In this regard, meetings have already been held with the officers of **Indus Hospital & Health Network** as well as **Aga Khan Hospital**. Furthermore, several visits have also been conducted to identify and inspect suitable sites for the proposed Nursing College. Once the matters with **Indus Hospital or Aga Khan Hospital** are finalized, further necessary proceedings will be initiated for the establishment of the Nursing College. Furthermore, in compliance with the directions of the Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan, Islamabad, proceedings are underway regarding the establishment of a Nursing College/Polytechnic College at Sub-Division Jatoi, District Muzaffargarh. In this connection, consultations and meetings are being held with various NGOs and other associations within Pakistan, as well as with representatives of various countries, including the United States of America, Switzerland, Italy, England, Canada, and China, which are expected to significantly facilitate the establishment of the said institutions.

**(MERIT BASED SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR TALENTED AND DESERVING STUDENTS)**

31. Before the Management Committee, Mr. Muzaffar Hussain Khan Magsi, the petitioner of HRC No.45/1993, proposed the initiation of a scholarship program for topper/high-marks achievers' children of Trust schools as well as for position-holder children of Government and Private Schools of District Muzaffargarh. In this regard, a committee of educationists was constituted to submit its report and recommendations. The committee has submitted its report. The same shall be discussed in the next meeting, and further necessary action will be taken accordingly

**(COMPUTER LABS, I.T & OFFICE EQUIPMENT)**

32. In the last meeting of the Management Committee, the Land Superintendent and Accountant of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh were directed to proceed further in the instant matter, procure the required I.T. and office equipment in accordance with the relevant rules and submit a report in the next meeting. However, no report has been submitted by the Land Superintendent and Accountant to date. Therefore, as per the report of Mr. Tahir Bashir, Principal/Director School Affairs/Member, it is proposed that an advertisement be published in the newspaper for the procurement of the below-mentioned I.T. equipment and other items through open tender:

**(RECRUITMENT OF TEACHERS ETC.)**

33. The Principals of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools at Alipur, Jatoi, and Kot Addu were consulted regarding the requirement of teaching and non-teaching staff, who have submitted the following staff requirements.

34. Therefore, the Committee has decided that the required staff for the aforementioned schools, as well as recovery personnels and Patwaries for the Trust Office, Muzaffargarh, be recruited. For this purpose, an advertisement shall be published in the newspapers immediately, so that the recruitment process may be completed at the earliest. In this regard, Mr. Tahir Bashir, Principal/Director School Affairs/Member, is directed to look into the matter and ensure that the process is completed at the earliest.

**(AUCTION OF CANTEENS SKKT SCHOOLS)**

35. For the auction of canteens of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools at Alipur, Jatoi, and Kot Addu, a committee has been constituted vide order Endst. No. 531/SKKT dated 12.03.2025. The committee inspected the designated areas for the canteens and examined other related matters. Upon review, the committee has submitted the following recommendations: -

(i) Immediate improvement of the canteen venues at Alipur and Jatoi through proper brick and cement construction, with roofing supported by girders and T-irons; and

(ii) Construction of a new room adjacent to the water filtration plant at Kot Addu School for canteen operations.

The committee has further recommended that subsequent action regarding the auctioning of canteens may be undertaken only after due consideration of these proposals. In this regard, the Principals of the concerned schools and the Accountant of the Trust are directed to obtain rough cost estimates from the private contractor/firms for the aforementioned works and submit a comprehensive report for further necessary action.

**(PURCHASE OF MOTORCYCLE FOR SARDAR KAURA KHAN TRUST, SCHOOL, JATOI)**

36. An application was received from the Principal, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust School, Jatoi, requesting the provision of one motorcycle for the performance of day-to-day official duties of the school. The said request was placed before the Management Committee for consideration. After deliberation on the matter and keeping in view the available resources and

necessity, the Committee did not find sufficient justification for the provision of a motorcycle at this stage. Therefore, the request of the Principal has been rejected by the Committee.

**(CONSTRUCTION OF WATER PLANTS AT SKKT SCHOOL, JATOI AND KOT ADDU)**

37. The Management Committee proposed that water filtration plants be installed at Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools Jatoi and Kot Addu, in order to provide safe and clean drinking water to the students and staff as well as local inhabitants. In this regard, the Accountant, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, is directed to obtain the necessary estimates for the installation of the said water plants and submit a detailed report before the Committee. Furthermore, the Land Superintendent, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, is also directed to contact relevant NGOs or Government Departments that install water filtration plants, with a view to exploring the possibility of having the plants installed free of cost so that the financial burden on the Trust may be minimized.

**(INSTALLATION OF SOLAR SYSTEM AT SKKT SCHOOLS JATOI, ALIPUR AND KOT ADDU)**

38. The Management Committee proposed that solar power systems be installed at Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools, Jatoi, Alipur, and Kot Addu in order to ensure an uninterrupted supply of electricity and to reduce the recurring expenditure on electricity bills. In this regard, the Accountant, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, is directed to obtain the necessary estimates for the installation of solar systems at the aforementioned schools and submit a detailed report before the Committee. Furthermore, the Land Superintendent, Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, is also directed to contact relevant NGOs or Government Departments working in the field of renewable energy to explore the possibility of installing the solar systems through their assistance or schemes so that the financial burden on the Trust may be minimized.

**(INSTALLATION OF AIR CONDITIONER FOR NURSERY, PREP AND PLAY GROUP AT SKKT SCHOOLS JATOI, ALIPUR AND KOT ADDU)**

**(PURCHASE OF LED 32 INCH FOR SKKT SCHOOLS JATOI, ALIPUR AND KOT ADDU)**

**(ELECTRIC GRASS CUTTER MACHINES FOR SKKT SCHOOL KOT ADDU AND ALIPUR)**

39. As the summer season has commenced and keeping in view the intensity of heat territorial environment and the weather conditions are becoming increasingly hot, the Management Committee considered the matter of providing a comfortable learning environment for the young students of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools at Jatoi, Alipur and Kot Addu.

The Committee observed that the students of Nursery, Prep and Play Group are very young and require a suitable and healthy classroom environment for their well-being and effective learning. Therefore, it has been proposed that air conditioners be installed in the classrooms of Nursery, Prep, and Play Group at the aforementioned schools so that the health and educational environment of these young students may be improved. The Committee further recommended that electric grass cutter machines be purchased for Sardar Kaura Khan Trust Schools at Kot Addu and Alipur to facilitate proper maintenance of the grounds (One for each School). The Committee also approved that two LEDs be procured and installed in all Sardar Kaura Khan Trust School to ensure effective monitoring through CCTV cameras. In this regard, the Accountant of Sardar Kaura Khan Trust, Muzaffargarh, is directed to initiate the necessary actions for the procurement and installation of the required air conditioners, electric grass cutter machine and LEDs and to submit a detailed report after completing all procedural formalities.

**40.** The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks extended to all the participants, expressing appreciation for their attendance, contributions and able assistance.
